<p><i>Madrone: Madrone leafminer</i></p>

Use Integrated Pest Management (IPM) for successful plant problem management.

Biology

Larvae of this leaf and twig mining moth blaze sinuous, serpentine mines across the upper sides of leaves. Since leafminers usually cause only minor damage, they do not affect the long-term health of the tree.

Management Options

Non-Chemical Management

~ Natural predators may help control populations. Encourage predators such as green lacewings and spiders.
